

Our study of Depth and Complexity continued with the icons 'Trends' and 'Language of the Discipline'. Trends are influences, forces, direction, course of action, or fads that we can explore when looking deeply at something. Students explore patterns that have changed over time, and the factors that influenced that change to discover trends. Language of the Discipline draws a focus to the vocabulary involved in an area of study. Students explore the specialized vocabulary, abbreviations, symbols, or phrases needed to understand and communicate new ideas on a topic. These two Depth and Complexity icons help students dive deeper into content and grasp complex ideas and areas of study.
