# WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

#### SINGLE ADULTS AND FAMILIES WHO:

- O HAVE STRONG TIES TO FULLERTON\*
- ARE MOTIVATED AND WILLING TO WORK TOWARDS HOUSING WITH A CASE MANAGER
- ARE WILLING AND ABLE TO PASS A BACKGROUND CHECK
- ARE NOT A REGISTERED SEX OFFENDER OR HAVE A HISTORY OF VIOLENT CRIME
- HAVE A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE, VEHICLE REGISTRATION, VEHICLE INSURANCE
- WILL ADHERE TO KEEPING THE SAFE PARKING LOT AND PROGRAM SECURE, SAFE AND CLEAN

#### \*STRONG TIES TO FULLERTON Include:

- > Has Fullerton Address on ID; Lived in Fullerton
- > Works or Has Worked in Fullerton
- > Frequents Fullerton Services or Programs
- > Has a Doctor in Fullerton
- > Attends a Church in Fullerton
- > Has been consistently staying in their car in Fullerton for at least the past 6 months
- > Is attending or has a child attending a School in Fullerton
