 - **Goal 1: Student Achievement**
 - By May 2023, we will maintain our iReady percentile score of 70 from Diagnostic 1 to Diagnostic 3 in ELA and maintain or increase our iReady percentile score from 67 to 70 from Diagnostic 1 to Diagnostic 3 in the area of Math.
 - By May 2023, the iReady percentile score for EL's in both ELA and Math will increase by 5% in both ELA and Math. From 51 to 54 in ELA and from 52 to 55 in Math
 - By Spring 2023, the overall SBAC ELA Distance From Standard (DFS) will maintain or increase the Distance From Standard by 3 points from 69 to 72 in ELA and 61 to 64 in Math.
