

Dress Code

- **Shirts**: No inappropriate designs and/or messages on shirts, regardless of cover-up garments. No plain white t-shirts. No low-cut tops, bare midriffs, halter tops, spaghetti straps, off-the-shoulder, strapless regardless of cover-up garments.
 - Showing undergarments or cleavage is unacceptable.
- Pants/Shorts/Skirts: No sagging, extremely baggy pants, or extremely low-rise pants. Shorts must have a minimum 3 inch inseam. Skirts and dresses must be mid-thigh in length.
- **Sweaters/Jackets**: No oversized clothing allowed.
- **Shoes:** No sandals, thongs, flip-flops, open-toed, backless shoes.
- **Hats/Hoods**: Beanies, baseball caps, and hoods are not allowed. Only full-brimmed hats may be worn outside.

- There will be occasional early release at 1:38 pm, notices will be sent out ahead of time




Parent Involvement
