Honors Classes



- Move at a faster pace
- Teach more in depth knowledge
- More homework is given than regular grade level classes
 - 9th Grade options can includes:
 - English Honors
 - Biology Honors
 - Geometry Honors
 - Algebra 2 Honors

Advanced Placement (AP)

- College level classes
- Can earn college credit if you pass AP exam
- 9th grade classes can include:
 - AP Human Geography
 - AP Computer Science
- Classes usually taken during 10th-12th grades
- Can be in academic classes such as English, History, Math
- Offered during elective classes
 - Examples of Art, Psychology, Theatre, Music Theory




International Baccalaureate (IB)



- Similar to AP: College level courses
- Can earn college credit when you pass exams
 - Can take individual IB classes or earn full IB diploma
 - Offered in academic and elective classes
 - Many schools offer classes that prepare you for both AP/IB exams

FJUHSD Open Enrollment



▶ School of Residence

The HS that you will attend depends on where you live within the city of Fullerton.

• 6 zones

Interdistrict Transfers: You **MUST** be a resident of the Fullerton Joint Union High School District.

If you are interested in attending one of the high schools, you may apply for an Interdistrict Transfer release from your district of residence



What is Open Enrollment?

- Between January 16-February 2, FJUHSD offers Open Enrollment for incoming 9th graders
- ➤ If you live between the Fullerton attendance boundary you can apply for any high school
- You will be mailed information in January that indicates your school of residence
- (make sure we have your correct mailing address on file)

More About Open Enrollment

- Students living in FJUHSD address boundaries
- If you live out of the boundaries, you can fill out an inter-district transfer from the school district that you live in
- Open enrollment acceptance is valid for 4 years; HOWEVER a minimum of 1 year attendance is required

- Acceptance to school does not mean acceptance to a program that is offered at that school
 - i.e. Troy Tech, EPIC, AVID
- Acceptance is based on the number of seats available at each school. Spaces are NOT based on first-come, first-serve basis. A lottery system will be established if number of applicants exceed the number of spaces
- Additional testing/application is required

Open Enrollment Procedures

- > If you plan to attend your school of residence, no action is needed
- If you plan to attend another school within FJUHSD, you need to pick up application from **ONLY** the **school of residence** starting on **January 16, 2024** and return packet by **February 2, 2024**
- > You will be notified in the end of February 2024 whether you are accepted at your school of choice
- You must register at the school of choice by early March to confirm your spot



Quick Note: You may only apply for 1 school. If more than 1 application is received for a student then BOTH applications will be voided and student will attend their school of residence

Be Prepared!

- Be prepared to submit copies of:
- Birth Certificate or Passport to legally verify age and name
- > Proof of Residency (current water, gas, or electric bill, rental agreement, or mortgage/escrow statement
- > Immunization Records
- Copy of your current transcript (to verify correct class placement)
- > Be prepared to discuss your course request with a counselor
- Incomplete enrollment packets will NOT be accepted
