Students Join New FSD Performance Academy Program to Access Athletic & Dance Academies

- Choice of Sports for boys and girls in grades 6-8
- Choice to select ANY Athletic/Dance Academy or similar training
- Partner with Delta Sports for an Onsite Drop off and Pick up FSD Option
- Initial Schools Rolling Hills and Parks JHS with potential expansion
- Begin in 2024/2025 School Year
- Transportation from Rolling Hills to Parks JHS for Athletic Academy with Delta Sports
- Schedule: Parks JHS is 5 periods in person, at school, 2 periods Performance Academy specific / Rolling Hills 9:00am to 1:00pm (combo of in person + PE Independent Study)

^{*}Currently you will need to arrange for transportation to other academies but possible transportation coordination in future

Must meet the following five criteria:

- Must engage participants for a minimum 90 minutes at least four days a
 week (weekend events not included), in physical activity, support
 personal growth, and promote healthy living and physical activity as
 lifelong goals and follow the state's content standards in physical
 education. Total hours during the week must be at least 7.5 hours a
 week.
- Must be a structured sports/dance academy program taught by specialized individuals responsible for supervising, documenting, and verifying student participation, progress, and performance.
- Must begin sport training/conditioning at least one period before the end of the school day.
- Must agree to enter Performance Academy ISPE Agreement including goal setting and attendance tracking.
- Must be an advanced athlete with national ranking.



FSD ISPE vs. Performance Academy



Current ISPE Program

Students participate in ISPE for a shortened <u>6-period day.</u> (No PE period.) Or stay on campus for a study hall period to complete homework.

Sport can start any time (does not have to start before school ends)

Similarities

Students must be an <u>advanced athlete</u> participating in an advanced level sports

Must Fill out an Independent Study PE Contract and Log Similarities and Differences



New Performance Academy Students engage in a specialized athletic program, <u>adopting a 5-period in</u> <u>person school day.</u>

PE and one elective are done as Independent Study PE.

Sport or Academy <u>must start before end</u> of school
