#### ABC K-3 (Arts Based Classroom)

- Individualized Daily Plans, tailored to unique student interests and needs.
- Integrated arts experiences in drama (including annual musical play), music appreciation and performance, dance, and visual arts, including master artist and author appreciation studies.
- Passionate about providing creative expression, learning choices and hands-on experiences in the classroom.
- Meaningful and purposeful learning experiences organized across grade and ability levels with big/little buddies and various other groupings.

#### LTL K-3 (Learning Through Literature)

- We use books as a springboard to all curricular areas including writing, reading, math, science, social studies, and art.
- Integrated units skillfully woven across all grade levels.
- Meaningful/hands-on learning experiences (writer's workshop, science experiments, buddy art, popcorn factory and consumer education).
- Weekly reading activities (partner reading, buddy reading, family reading, parent and student mystery readers, author's share).

#### <u>Upper Multiage Learning Community 4-6 (Sangulo)</u>

Multiage classes are created when children of different ages and grade levels are intentionally combined in a single classroom to realize academic success, social development, and leadership opportunities.

At the end of each year, the older students move on to the next grade and a new group of students enters at the lower grade. This provides the opportunity for students to spend more than one year with our team of teachers, creating a family of learners. Our program offers a unique way to prepare students to be successful academically, socially and emotionally as they advance through higher grades.

- In the 3 years, all the standards in ELA, Math, Science and Social Studies for the three grade levels are taught.
- Instructional Grouping by Grade level for Math and ELA lessons, and Whole class grouping for writing, social studies, science, and literature lessons.
- A part of the day is dedicated to independent research and learning, which teaches our students to be independent workers who can self motivate and manage their time wisely.
- All students participate in a musical in the spring.

We maintain rigorous academic standards, while fostering a sense of community and connection between students in all 3 grades.
