

Spelling Unit 3 Plural Noun Patterns



Rules: If a noun ends with a vowel + y, add “s” to make it plural.
Example: **toy** - toys **play** - plays

If a noun ends with a consonant + y, you must change the “y” to “i” and add “es”. This rule also applies to verbs

Example: **bunny** - bunnies **try**-tries
