## Absences and Make-Up Work

Daily attendance is important since the majority of the class time on introducing and practicing key concepts.

- Students with absences must arrange with Mrs. Wilmoth a time to make up the test, within two days of returning to school. <u>It is the student's responsibility</u> to get the assignment online, from another student, or to meet with Mrs. Wilmoth before or after school. Make-up work is must be turned in to Mrs. Wilmoth after school (days to be determined).
- <u>Late homework</u>: Any homework turned in after the due date (usually the day after it is assigned, will only receive 80% credit up to the first two weeks. Any homework after two weeks from the due date will earn 60%. No late homework will be accepted on the last week of the grading quarter.

#### iPad and Math Folder

Students will use folders to organize notes and homework. Students are expected to bring their iPads and math folders to class **every day.** 

## About the Class

This is a year long math class that covers both the Math 7 standards. This includes rational numbers; one-step and two-step equations and inequalities; unit rates and percent; and an introduction to other principles. Students will need to expend the necessary efforts in the classroom and at home to master the concepts.

### **Classroom Expectations**

- Be on time (before the bell rings) and remain in your seat until you are excused.
- Remain on task throughout the class period.
- Respect others, using respectful language and appropriate behavior.
- No cell phones, gum, food or drinks in class.

#### Homework

Students are expected to complete homework on a daily basis to practice and reinforce the concepts learned in class. Assignments and answers are posted on my website. It is imperative students check the answers for the homework in the book and the website. This allows students to evaluate and correct their work accordingly. Students should ask any questions in class for problems they were not able to solve. They should not take more than a few minutes on any one problem.
