- Homeless Education Policy


Funding Support for English Learners

- Funds targeted and restricted specifically to support English learner programs include Federal Title III and State LCFF Supplemental (includes EL, foster youth and low income and achieving).
- These funds are used for educational materials, professional development, interventions, and personnel to support EL students.
- All school sites receive funds based on the number of EL students identified through the CELDT.




Monitoring


Opportunity and equal Education Access

Structured English Immersion (SEI)

- A language acquisition program for English learners in which nearly all classroom instruction is provided in English, but with curriculum and a presentation designed for pupils who are learning English.
- ► At minimum, students are offered ELD and access to grade level academic subject matter content.

Alternative Program (ALT): Dual Language

- Also referred to as Two-Way Immersion.
- ► A language acquisition program that provides language learning and academic instruction for native speakers of English and native speakers of another language, with the goals of high academic achievement, first and second language proficiency, and cross-cultural understanding.
- This program begins in Kindergarten and continues to eighth grade.



ARTICLE IV OFFICERS

SECTION 1. OFFICERS

The officers of the DELAC shall be a chairperson and **four** vice-chair(s). Any site elected ELAC member may be nominated for an office.

SECTION 2. ELECTION AND TERM OF OFFICE

The officers of the DELAC shall be elected at the second DELAC meeting, and shall serve during the **two** calendar years in which elected and until each successor has been elected and qualified. Any officer may be re-elected provided he/she continues to be a member.
