Demographics and Language Information: Rossana explained what our demographics were at our District office: 51% Hispanic, 21% Asian. 3900 students are EL (English Learners). There are 38 different languages spoken in the Fullerton School District. Anything above 15% the district has to provide all information in that language

PTA COUNCIL: invited everyone to participate and join the Fullerton Council PTA, DISCOVERY CENTER: provided information about programs for students, CSUF HEALTHY NEIGHBOORHOODS: Offer classes and resources according to their clients needs, OC United, and FSD Technology and Media Center were also there.
