Welcome: The meeting began at 9:07 a.m. with a welcome from Rossana Fonseca. She thanked Mrs. Robyn Clemente, Nicolas Jr. High School Principal for hosting the meeting and the parents for providing delicious breakfast snacks. Dr. Emy Flores, Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services was introduced and thanked for attending.

Nicolas Update: Mrs. Clemente shared about Nicolas' many programs that include the STEM Pathways program for Engineering and Design, STEAM for Art and Design, Computer Science Coding to develop working apps, Robotics for programming and coding and the AVID College program. A video of the working app Bully Busters created by Nicolas students was shared.

Approval of September Minutes: Maria Ayala motioned to approve the minutes and seconded by Egleth Nuncci.

DELAC Election Nominations: ELAC site representatives are the only school representatives that can run for DELAC Chair and Co-chair positions. Nominated for the 2016/2017 school year were Alma Chavez. Veronica Moran, Egleth Nuncci, Rudolfo Ayala and Brenda Trejo. The DELAC Chair and Co-chair responsibilities will be to meet with the Educational Services team to provide input to DELAC agendas, co-lead and present at DELAC meetings and update the School Board.

English Classes-NOCCCD School of Continuing Education: Melissa de la Cruz shared the three main ESL locations are at the Wilshire, Cypress and Anaheim campuses with 38 off site community partner locations at schools, parks and churches. The classes are completely free with six levels of ESL classes offered. Commonwealth and Pacific Drive Schools are two off site locations offering the ESL classes. Brochures were provided and schools interested in being an off site location can contact Mr. Carlos Perez, Ph.D. Mr. Carlos Perez, Ph.D., shared he is an ESL instructor at Pacific Drive School teaching adults English as a second language in a multilevel class and invited all parents to attend. He shared NOCCCD offers many other programs such as classes for high school diplomas, citizenship, technical certificates, vocational and computer classes, and classes to pursue a higher education such as an AA or BA. Assessment centers are also available offering tutoring and academic counseling. Their goal is to have parents continue with their education and succeed after graduation.

Fullerton College Financial Aid: Rachel Tucker and Julie Zaragoza informed parents free funding for student aid from federal and state funds are available and the deadline to apply is March 2nd. Any person ready to attend college or a career school should apply by filling out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, (FAFSA) application. For more information on the types of aid available, eligibility criteria, when to apply and completing the FAFSA application, parents can go to the website, studentaid.gov.

OC Safe from the Start: Victoria Johnson shared about violence at schools and techniques on how to cope and deal with trauma in life. A video was shown on children's violence and its life long effects, and on the power of healthy parent relationships. Surveys and evaluations were handed out and parents were encouraged to take workbooks home. Schools interested in an in depth training can talk to Rossana for more information.
