Background: The District and California School Employees Association (CSEA #130) have

been unable to resolve contract negotiations related to salaries for the

2007/2008 school year. CSEA requested that the parties enter into mediation. Mediation was not successful in resolving the issues of salary and the District and CSEA #130 were moved to Factfinding. Factfinding is a process that will generate a non-binding recommendation to the District and CSEA #130. The agreement with School Services of California allows for \$255.00 per hour plus expenses. In addition the District can be billed at \$95.00 per hour for SSC

support staff assistance.

Rationale: The District utilizes experts in resolving disputes that may affect the proper

running of the District. CSEAs requests involve a reduction in hundreds of thousands of dollars to the restricted and unrestricted general fund. School Services of California is one of the most respected budgetary advisory groups in the State. The use of such expert consultants to help establish the District's

current budgetary status will be critical to the resolution of Factfinding.

Funding: Budget 523.

Recommendation: Approve/Ratify Special Services Agreement with School Services of California

(SCC) for expert assistance with CSEA #130 Factfinding.

#### AGREEMENT FOR SPECIAL SERVICES

Factfinding

This is an agreement between **FULLERTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT**, hereinafter referred to as "Client," and **SCHOOL SERVICES OF CALIFORNIA, INC.**, hereinafter referred to as "Consultant," entered into as of July 27, 2009.

#### RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Client needs assistance regarding services relative to factfinding; and

**WHEREAS**, SCHOOL SERVICES OF CALIFORNIA, INC., is professionally and specially trained and competent to provide these services; and,

**WHEREAS**, the authority for entering into this agreement is contained in Section 53060 of the Government Code and such other provisions of California law as may be applicable;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the parties to this agreement do hereby mutually agree as follows:

- 1. The Consultant agrees to assist the Client as directed by the Superintendent or Superintendent's designees with issues for services relative to district collective bargaining negotiations as mandated by Sections 3540, et al., of the California Government Code.
- 2. The Client agrees to pay Consultant \$255 per hour, plus expenses, to review budget and negotiation documents, provide preliminary consultation, and perform other services required prior to or beyond the initial negotiation stage. Time spent by SSC support staff to prepare materials will be billed at \$95 per hour.
  - a. "Hours" are defined as hours of direct service to the Client, as well as reasonable travel time to and from the Client's site.
  - b. "Expenses" are defined as actual, out-of-pocket expenses, such as transportation, lodging, meals, long-distance telephone charges, cellular telephone charges, fax, postage, and duplication.
- 3. This Agreement shall be for the period commencing July 27, 2009, and terminating November 30, 2009. It may be terminated at any time prior to November 30, 2009, by either party hereto on thirty (30) days notice. In case of cancellation, the Client shall be liable for any costs accrued as of the cancellation date.

4. It is expressly understood and agreed to by both parties that Consultant, while carrying out and complying with any of the terms and conditions of this Agreement, is an independent contractor and is not an employee of the District.

which have become obsolete, unserviceable, unrepairable, or otherwise not suitable for school use. Some of these items may be salvaged or sold, thus

providing the District with some recovery of residual value.

The Fiscal Services Department is requesting that obsolete items, which have been collected from District sites, be declared as surplus property and "not suitable for school purposes." These surplus items were collected from all sites at the direction of site managers. All items have been made available to District employees to claim for school use prior to holding a public auction. The remaining items are designated as "not suitable for school purposes" and offered for sale. For those items that do not sell, the Assistant Superintendent, Business Services, requests Board authorization to declare the property is of

insufficient value to defray the costs of arranging for another sale and to dispose of said property by other means as allowed by Education Codes 17545

and 17546.

Rationale: The surplus-holding areas are nearing capacity and need to be cleaned out after

summer pickup throughout the Fullerton School District.

Funding: Not applicable.

<u>Recommendation:</u> Declare listed items as surplus not suitable for school purposes and authorize

District staff to dispose of items at a public auction or by other means as

allowed by Education Codes 17545 and 17546.

## District Records

The approved budget, statistical compilations, reports, notices, bulletins, memoranda, minutes of meetings and official communications between governmental branches are public records, and access thereto during normal hours of business shall be granted to any citizen. School records will be examines in the presence of the record custodian regularly responsible for maintenance of files.

The Board of Trustees recognizes the right of citizens to have access to public records of the District. The Board intends the District to provide any person reasonable access to the public records of the schools and District during normal business hours and within the requirements of State and federal law. Such records shall be examined in the presence of the staff member regularly responsible for their maintenance.

The District may charge for copies of public records or other materials requested by individuals or groups. The charge shall be based on the actual costs of duplication, as determined by the Superintendent or designee and as specified in the administrative regulation.

Not included in the category of records to which the privilege of access is given are:

- 1. Personnel records.
- Student records.
- 3. Personal correspondence.

Public access shall not be given to records listed as exempt from public disclosure in the California Public Records Act or other statutes.

### **Procedure and Materials**

Ideas, operating procedures and publications developed in or for the School District may be made available to outside nonprofit or profit organizations for use or distribution when such use or distribution will reflect favorable upon the School District and the community. No outside organization shall be granted exclusive access to, or control over this material.

#### School Improvement Plan Information

The information required for the ongoing evaluation and modification of the school improvement plan be the school site council will be made available to any person on request, except that no student or staff person shall be identified. The information shall be available at the school, and a reasonable charge will be made when copies of any materials are requested.

<u>Uniform Complaint Procedures-Concerning Educational Programs Page 1</u> Board Adopted <u>11/4/08</u> Revised:

Policy No.: 1312.3

The Board of Trustees recognizes that the District has primary responsibility for ensuring that it complies with state and federal laws and regulations governing educational programs. The District shall investigate and seek to resolve complaints at the local level. The Board encourages the early, informal resolution of complaints at the site level whenever possible. The District shall follow Uniform Complain Procedures pursuant to state regulations when addressing complaints alleging unlawful discrimination or failure to comply with the law in consolidated categorical programs, child care and development programs, child nutrition programs and special education programs. The district shall investigate complaints alleging failure to comply with such laws and/or alleging discrimination and shall seek to resolve those complaints in accordance with the district's uniform complaint procedures. (5 CCR 4620)

The District shall follow Uniform Complaint Procedures when addressing complaints alleging unlawful discrimination against any protected group as identified under Education Code 200 and 220 and Government Code 11135, including actual or perceived sex, sexual orientation, gender, ethnic group identification, race, ancestry, national origin, religion, color, or mental or physical disability, or age, or on the basis of a person's association with a person or group with one or more of these actual or perceived characteristics in any District program or activity that received or benefits from state financial assistance.

Uniform complaint procedures shall also be used when addressing complaints alleging failure to comply with state and/or federal laws in adult education program, consolidated categorical aid programs, migrant education, career technical and technical education and career technical and technical training programs, child care and development programs, child nutrition programs, and special education programs.

Complaints concerning special education programs shall be addressed in accordance with the regulations and procedures set forth in Federal Law and the State Education Code, which are included in the North Orange County Special Education Local Plan. The Uniform Complaint Procedures are included in the Parents Rights which are Rights that are provided to the parent/guardian during the referral and Individualized Education Plan processes.

Complaints related to sufficiency of textbooks or instructional materials, emergency or urgent facilities conditions that pose a threat to the health of safety of students or staff, and teacher vacancies and misassignments shall be investigated pursuant to the district's Williams uniform complaint procedure.

The Board of Trustees prohibits retaliation in any form for the filing of the complaint, the reporting of instances of discrimination, or for participation in complaint procedures. Such participation shall not in any way affect the status, grades, or work assignments of the complainant.

The Board of Trustees acknowledges and respects every individual's student and employee rights to privacy. Complaints shall be investigated in a manner that protects the confidentiality of the parties and the integrity of the process. This may include keeping the identity of the complainant confidential, as appropriate and except to the extent necessary to carry out the

investigation or proceedings, as determined by the Superintendent or designee, on a case-by-case basis these rights. The identity of any complainant shall be kept as confidential as appropriate.

The Board recognizes that a neutral mediator can often suggest a compromise that is agreeable to all parties in a dispute. In accordance with uniform complain procedures, whenever all parties to a complaint agree to try resolving their problem through mediation, the Superintendent of designee shall initiate that process. The superintendent or designee shall ensure that the results are consistent with state and federal laws and regulations.

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that employees designated to receive and investigate complaints are knowledgeable about the laws and programs for which they are responsible. Such employees may have access to legal counsel as determined by the Superintendent or designee.

## Compliance Officer(s)

The Board designates the Assistant Superintendent of Personnel Services, 1401 West Valencia Drive, Fullerton, California 92833, (714) 447-7450 as the District's compliance officer to receive complaints, direct investigation of complaints, maintain records of complaints and subsequent related actions, and ensure District compliance with law.

## **Notifications**

The Superintendent or designee shall meet the notification requirements of the Code of Regulations, Title 5, Section 4622, including the annual dissemination of District **Uniform** Complaint Procedures and information about available appeals, civil law remedies, and conditions under which the complaint may be taken directly to the California Department of Education. This notification must be (a) in English; (b) in the primary language of the students when 15% or more of the students in a school speak that language; or (c) in the mode of communication of the recipient of the notice.
