The CELDT measures four domains: listening and speaking, reading, and writing. The CELDT is not an appropriate testing instrument to determine English proficiency for some of our special education moderate to severely disabled population, as it requires levels of responses beyond the developmental levels of the students. The California Department of Education recommends that the <i>Alternate Language Proficiency Instrument</i> (ALPI) and the <i>Student Oral Language Observation Matrix</i> (SOLOM) be used as alternate assessments for students with significant disabilities.			
	The California Department of Education requires the Fullerton School District Board of Trustees to approve the ALPI and the SOLOM as alternate assessments for our moderate/severely handicapped students.

The PAR Joint Panel has completed the Spring 2003 application process for PAR Staff Development Teacher positions beginning September 1, 2003 and continuing for three years. Six Staff Development Teachers have been selected by the Joint Panel. Two are returning teachers and four are newly selected teachers. They will join four other Staff Development Teachers and five Consulting Teachers.

The following teachers were approved on June 10, 2003, for a stipend of \$2800.00 for 90 hours: Kathy Kellerman (Acacia), Debbie Rhoads (Laguna Road), Susan Sutton (Pacific Drive), Yaelan Choo (Sunset Lane), Lori Van Herk (Valencia Park), and Leanne Pionke (Woodcrest). Because of budget cuts, that stipend has been reduced to \$2334.00 for 75 hours.

The following PAR teachers will continue as Consulting Teachers and Staff Development Teachers and will receive a stipend of \$2334.00 for 75 hours: Becky D'Arrigo (Beechwood), Kim Bass (Valencia Park), Kelli Edwards (Hermosa), Nancy Henderson (Raymond), Connie Learn (Valencia Park), Edna Melton (Valencia Park), Barbara Moore (District), Kyle Stava (Valencia Park) and Elaine Swank (Richman).

The members of the Joint Panel are to be commended for their contribution to and support of the PAR program. They are: Marion Braddick, Kit Dameron, Linda Kelley, Darlene Naslund, Paula Pitluk, and Jeff Dotson. Janet Steger is the District Liaison to the Panel.

Funding:The PAR program is funded through the California Department of Education
(CDE) and the State law which regulates the use of these funds. In the last
year, the PAR budget has been reduced by over 80%. The PAR stipend has
been determined according to the PAR Agreement: Section 6: Compensation:

The stipend for Staff Development Teachers for 2003-2004 is \$2334.00, based on 75 hours times the contractual hourly rate per academic year. This stipend was renegotiated by FETA and the District, after the budget cuts by the CDE. The PAR Joint Panel has adjusted the budget for 2003-2003 to cover all of the expenses of the PAR program.

Due to state budget cuts, the Joint Panel reduced its stipend from \$3,000 to \$1,800 per academic year. This stipend will be provided pending funding and negotiations				
	The four teachers selected for the Joint Panel by the Fullerton Elementary Teachers Association are Darlene Naslund (Commonwealth), Jeff Dotson (Ladera Vista), Marion Braddick (Pacific Drive), and Linda Kelley (Sunset Lane).				
Funding:	The PAR program is funded through the California Department of Education (CDE) and the State law which regulates the use of these funds.
