SUBJECT: APPROVE INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT WITH ANDREA

REYNOLDS

<u>Background:</u> The Fullerton School District has, for many years, provided special education

program services to students with moderate and severe learning disabilities within the North Orange County SELPA. In recent years, there have been delays in payment on the part of some user districts due to disagreement regarding the funds due the Fullerton School District. In order to bring

resolution to prior years receivables, which exceed \$700,000 through the 2005-06 school year, and to develop a methodology for future years' financials, there

will be future mediation and meetings. Andrea Reynolds, now the Chief Business Officer at Lowell Joint School District, was the Fullerton School District Director of Fiscal Services and was the person involved with the most detail in these financial transactions. Ms. Reynolds' knowledge of SELPA

financial history is necessary for a timely financial resolution. Staff

recommends Board approval of an Independent Contractor Agreement with Andrea Reynolds at a rate of \$90 per hour for a period not to exceed ten days.
