How will these opportunities be different than the regular school day?

What is **Supplemental Instruction**? (Academic)

 "Supplemental instruction" means the instructional programs provided in addition to and complementary to the LEAs regular instructional programs.

Examples:

- Intervention (Reading/Math)
- Small group tutoring
- Summer Learning Academy
- Longer school day/year

What type of **Supports** can be funded? (Non-Academic)

 "Support" means interventions and services that are designed to meet students' needs for behavioral, social, emotional, and other integrated student supports, in order to enable students to engage in, and benefit from, the supplemental instruction being provided.

Examples:

- Health, counseling, or other mental health services
- Enrichment activities/programs that integrate social-emotional skill building
- Access to school meal programs
- Afterschool programs that offer homework help and engage students in hands-on learning (e.g. STEAM, Arts, VAPA)
- Training for school staff on strategies to engage families in addressing students' social-emotional health and academic needs
