FULLERTON SCHOOL DISTRICT Fullerton School District Outperforms State and County

(*Fullerton, CA*) – The California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress, or CAASPP, is the cornerstone of the state's system for evaluating the progress of public schools. As results were released, Fullerton School District (FSD) students outperformed the state average by double digits in all categories and outperformed Orange County scores in all but one category.

In Orange County, 57.4 percent of students met or exceeded grade-level English standards, surpassing the statewide average of 46.7 percent. FSD students fared better than both Orange County and the State with an average of 57.5 percent.

In mathematics, FSD students again substantially surpassed the state's average, with 50.0 percent meeting or exceeding grade-level standards compared to 34.6 percent for the rest of California and 46.8% for Orange County.

"I am very grateful to all our staff and their dedication to providing outstanding academic instruction to the children we serve in the Fullerton School District," said Dr. Robert Pletka, Superintendent.

Orange County's averages in English and math were at least five points higher than the neighboring counties of San Diego, Los Angeles, Ventura, Riverside, San Bernardino and Santa Barbara. As standardized test scores across California remain on the path to post-pandemic recovery, FSD students are outperforming both the county and state averages and appear to be leading the recovery.
