## BYLAWS OF THE BOARD

## President

At the annual organizational meeting the Governing Board shall elect a president from among its members.

The president of the Governing Board shall preside at all meetings of the Board, maintain order, enforce the rules of the board at all meetings, sign all bonds, notes, agreements, contracts, titles and leases and other legal instruments ordered to be executed by the Board, appoint all standing committees and all special committees, unless otherwise ordered by the Board.

In case of the resignation, absence, or disability of the president, the vice-president shall perform the duties of the president. In case of the absence or disability of both the president and vice-president, the Board shall choose a president pro tempore, who shall perform all of the duties of the president.

The president shall have all the rights of any member of the board, including the right to move, second, discuss, and vote on any and all questions before the Board.

The president has the power to call special meetings of the Board.
