

COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Local Agencies

It is the policy of the Board of Trustees to maintain effective working relationships with all local governmental agencies particularly those which affect the operations of the schools.

The Superintendent is directed to work closely and cooperatively with such agencies, and to bring all areas of conflict to the Board of Trustees whenever it appears that they cannot be promptly and appropriately resolved.

The Board further directs the Superintendent to advise any local agency or organization of any proposed change in policy or regulation which affects it.
