

How to Start a Training Test

- 1 Navigate to <https://www.caaspp.org>.
- 2 Select the **Practice & Training Tests** button.
- 3 Select the **Student Interface Practice and Training Tests** button.
- 4 Select the **Sign In** button to sign into the test as a guest.
- 5 Select either grade five, eight, or high school from the **Grade** drop down menu.
- 6 Select the California Science Test (CAST) training test.
