Mirroring national trends, Orange County is now seeing an increase in the number of lab-confirmed COVID-19 cases. Health officials have announced that Orange County has fallen back into the state's most restrictive "purple tier".

We will remain vigilant with all health and safety measures and this will not change the in-person and virtual instructional programs currently offered by the Fullerton School District and your child's school. The current program options of 5-day in-person, Hybrid in-person, MyFSD Academy, and virtual instruction will continue even though we are in the "purple tier".

State guidelines say that if a county falls back into the "purple tier" from a less restrictive tier, schools that have already resumed in-person instruction can, in fact, stay open with the necessary precautions.
